STATUTORY CONSULTATION ON KEUPER GAS STORAGE PROJECT (KGSP) LAUNCHED

Following the first stage of consultation on proposals to develop further gas storage at Holford Brinefield earlier this year, we have today launched statutory consultation on plans for the Keuper Gas Storage Project (KGSP).

The statutory consultation period will run from Thursday 2nd October 2014 to Thursday 27th November 2014, when local people will be encouraged to learn more about the proposals and have their say on the proposed development.

As part of this process Keuper Gas Storage Limited (KGSL), a wholly-owned subsidiary of INEOS Enterprises Group Limited, will be holding several Information Days, which employees are very welcome to attend.
